

## **Strategy #15** Planner for Writing a Newspaper Article

Headline	
Write the headline you would use to	
capture your audience's attention.	
Lead	
Create an opening to capture	
interest, suspense or surprise.	
Body – 5W Plus – Who, What, Where, When, Why, How	
Who are the characters/people	
involved?	
What was the problem, issue or	
event?(be specific)	
Use transitions to explain.	
(First, after that, next, then, soon,	
immediately, after, at last, finally.)	
Where did the problem, issue or	
event incident take place?	
When did the problem, issue or	
event take place?	

Why did the problem, issue or event take place?	
How did people feel about the	
problem, issue or event?	
<b>Direct Comment (Quote)</b> Include a comment someone might have said about the incident. (or create one for this article if one is not available) Tell who said it. Place it in a key spot in the news article.	
<b>Ending -</b> Create a suitable ending to conclude the newspaper article.
